


This Month's Bible Verse



FINANCIAL BRIEF

The original loan amount for the new Learning Center was \$4,162,200. The current balance as of August 31, 2024, is \$3,097,208.

As you read this, we have begun the fourth quarter of 2024. We enter this last quarter of the year much like we have entered the final quarter of the previous several years – having accumulated a sizable budget deficit. In the last few years, God has moved our congregation as a whole, and deficits have been wiped out with generous giving in the last three months of the year. Let's finish 2024 strong! One place to start – if you have automatic payments to the church established, please review to ensure payment information is current and contributions are being made as intended. Also, if it's been a while since you set up your recurring payments, the Kindrid interface has changed to allow you to add on an amount to cover processing fees; please consider checking this box to help the church cover the cost of providing this convenient payment method.

In addition to opening the fourth quarter with a deficit, another thing happening right now is our ministry groups are developing budgets for 2025. One's faith can be stretched when planning to invest in all the things we do to nurture relationships with God and bring Christ's love to the community, while knowing we currently have a large deficit; it is a little uncomfortable. "Discomfort" was one of the themes when a few of our brothers and sisters, on a recent Sunday morning, shared their experiences at the New Room conference. If we're comfortable, we're probably not maxing out our capacity for which we were created. As we head into the holiday season and a new year, may we be full of a bold love and pervasive hope, seeking and honoring God with our hearts, minds, time and finances.
