Greetings Aldersgate,

We have already reached the 2nd month of the new year and as we look back at 2024 we have been richly blessed with faithfulness to close out the year: almost \$20k given for our Christmas Eve offering for Convoy of Hope and over \$30k in new giving to our operating fund. Giving has been down to churches and charities, but we have seen an increase. We did have funds in reserve to cover the deficit from 2024, and with the inclusion of our principal in last year's budget, and the December purchase of a new mower we are looking good for 2025. I would encourage everyone to stay up to date with your regular giving and let's try and get through the first quarter with at least \$300k in giving to cover ministry expenses.

We will schedule Town Halls from our Task Force to discuss how we will move forward as a local church in the future. We continue to pray for discernment but are excited to hear more about the direction God is leading us in faith.

Are you growing in holiness? How might you take this month to seek God's holiness in your life? We are challenged to grow together and increase in our love and encouragement to one another and the world!

Please watch for our students to be serving February 2nd, throughout the 9:45 hour!



# Financial Brief BEN STONE

**CURRENT AS OF 12-31-24** 

Year-to-date financial summary through December 31, 2024:

Revenue	\$1,124,074
Budgeted Expenses	\$1,336,770
Actual Expenses	\$1,188,664
Net	\$ (64,590)

The original amount of the loan for the new Learning Center was \$4,162,200. The current balance as of December 31, 2024, is \$3,044,196.

We entered December with a year-to-date budget deficit of almost \$140,000. December was a tremendous month for giving – about twice the amount of a normal month! This made up more than half of the deficit; we ended the year in the red by about \$65,000. Thank you to everyone who sacrificed in December to give extra to the church to help try to make our budget. We have cash reserves to cover that deficit this year, but we obviously can't have a shortfall every year or eventually, we would not be able to support our ministry. A prayer for the future is that we all continue to grow in our stewardship.

Notably, while we had an operating fund deficit of \$65,000, there was \$69,000 given to the Legacy fund during 2024. Since the loan principal payments were included in the operating budget starting in 2024, the giving to the Legacy fund was used for additional principal payments on top of our normal monthly payments, helping to pay down the loan quicker, which is great. But since the scheduled monthly payments are now included in the operating budget, giving to the Legacy fund is no longer absolutely necessary; if you have been giving to the Legacy fund, please consider redirecting these gifts to the general operating fund starting in 2025, at least until we are meeting our budget on a consistent monthly basis.

While we came up short in meeting our annual budget, the special offering collected at the Christmas Eve services was a great success! A goal had been set of \$16,450, and we exceeded it – Aldersgate was able to give Convoy of Hope a little over \$20,000! It is glorious that despite hearing in recent weeks and months about our own budget issues within our comfortable church in Nixa, you were inspired by hope to take advantage of an opportunity to offer God's blessing to others on the other side of the globe. While we must take care of our own business, would we be fulfilling our purpose if we were not shining God's light to the world? It is exciting to see what we can do together as a church!


